TOKYO volunteer legacy network

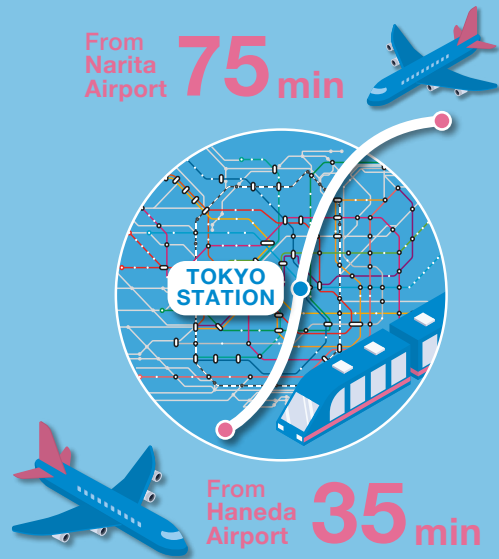

New Environmental Technologies

World-leading hydrogen fuel cell buses are proactively introduced on the streets of the Japanese capital, being part of the city's efforts to realise the ‘Zero Emission Tokyo’. You will be seated very comfortably, as hydrogen buses do not have engines so there is little noise or shaking. The buses are 100% accessible.

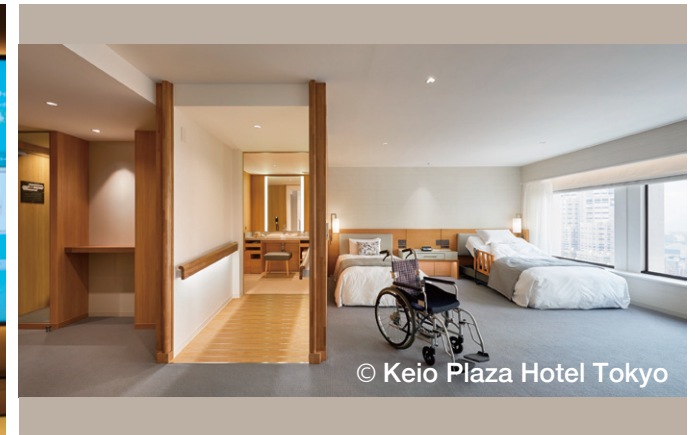

Tokyo is a gateway of Japan, connecting all the regions with comfortable travel through flights, Shinkansen, boats, buses, etc.



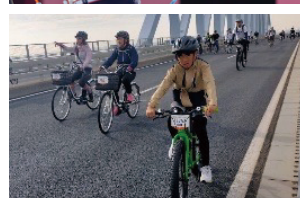
